The purpose of the school-parent compact is to communicate a common understanding of school and home responsibilities to assure that every student attains a quality education.

School Responsibilities:

- Create a welcoming and positive learning environment for students and parents.
- Provide a safe and healthy school environment that promotes learning.
- Respect and promote equity and the success of every student.
- Provide a quality, standards-based curriculum.
- Provide quality instruction by highly qualified staff.
- Assign meaningful assignments and activities to promote student success.
- Provide ongoing feedback to parents, in a timely manner, about student academic progress, including a printed progress report sent home three times per school year.
- Provide parents reasonable access to staff to address student concerns.

Parent Responsibilities:

- Encourage a positive attitude toward school.
- Require regular attendance and ensure student arrives to school on time.
- Read the Salem-Keizer School District Parent-Student Handbook.
- Encourage 20 minutes of student reading every day (including weekends) at home.
- Set aside a specific time in a quiet location for student to complete homework.
- Engage with and support student in his or her learning (e.g. review homework, ask about reading, or ask about the day at school).
- Check student's red folder every day and return all papers that require a signature or comments.
- Attend parent-teacher conferences and other school functions.
- Contact teachers when questions or concerns arise.
- Respect the personal rights of others.
- Update family information as needed with the school office.
- Make sure that student is rested and ready for school (9 hours of sleep are recommended for elementary students).

Student Responsibilities:

- Be safe, respectful, and responsible.
- Practice a growth mindset (*I can learn anything!*).
- Ask questions about my learning and for help when needed.
- Be ready for learning by having all materials and information needed at school and at home.
- Give parent/guardian my red folder every day and return signed forms to school.
- Read for at least 20 minutes at home every day (including weekends).
- Attend school regularly, arrive on time, follow school rules, and be well rested.
- Respect the personal rights and property of others.
